

# PEWITT FFA AG MECHANICS TEAM

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Student and Parent understand that:

- 1). Participant must be an active member in the Pewitt FFA Chapter.
- 2). Participant must be currently enrolled in Welding I or Welding II.
- 3). Participant will take pride in all projects that are built in the Pewitt Agricultural Education Shop.
- 4). Participant will adhere to all shop safety rules at all times.
- 5). Participant will strive to be no more than 1/16" off on all projects that are built in the Pewitt Agricultural Education Shop.
- 6). Participant may be required to spend extra time outside the class periods to complete projects and does hereby agree to spend this time as necessary.
- 7). Participant agrees to follow the directions of all Pewitt FFA Advisors, not only in class but also on all trips away from Pewitt High School.
- 8). Participant will NOT, under any circumstances, allow their grades to fall below a 70 in any class.
- 9). Participant will treat every teacher with the respect due that teacher no matter the circumstances.
- 10). Participant will assist in gaining sponsorships for contest expenses, which includes selling a minimum of 20 meat items and 20 fruit items.
- 11). Participant will not be put in ISS, out of school suspension, or AEP for any reason.
- 12). Parent/guardian will provide a student medical release form that will be kept on file in the event medical attention is needed and parent cannot be contacted.
- 13). Participant must cooperate with all other members of the team to do what is best for the team, and the Pewitt FFA Chapter.
- 14). Participant must follow all Rules and Codes of Conduct printed in the Pewitt High School Student Handbook because this is a school activity.
- 15). Should a participant be involved in any type of accident while at a competition, the sponsor, Pewitt FFA, and Pewitt CISD will be held harmless.
- 16). Participant will conduct themselves in a manner that is deemed appropriate by the Pewitt FFA Advisors on all trips away from Pewitt High School.
- 17). Participant understands that failure to abide by these guidelines could result in dismissal from team or elimination of project from competition.
- 18). All team members are required to travel to the shows with the team. This is a team and we travel together as one. We will also be staying at the same motel when we travel overnight.
- 19). Parents are encouraged to attend the shows with us. All parents wishing to attend with us must go by the office and fill out the proper paperwork to become a chaperone.
