

## **Greater Leander FFA 2019 – 2020 Junior Superintendent Program**

**Description:** Individuals will work cooperatively with Greater Leander Show Board members, volunteers, participants and judges in creating a quality show.

## **General Responsibilities, Requirements and Expectations:**

- Only students enrolled in a Leander ISD FFA Chapter will be eligible to participate in the Junior Superintendent Program.
  - Applicants must be in 9th-12th grade.
- Be in good academic standing (C average and above) at your school or equivalent.
- Be in good standing as a FFA member.
- Students that have served on the Jr. Superintendent Program will not be able serve a second time.
- Assist the livestock superintendents, general superintendent, youth fair superintendents with various areas: Check in/Check out, Judging, Auction and any other events that may come up.
- Always maintain a professional attitude when handling participants.
- Promote the show as a positive educational opportunity for youth to exhibit their projects.
- Behave as a good role model at all times (at school, outside of the classroom & during all Greater Leander activities).
- Dress appropriately at all Greater Leander activities.
- 12 students will be selected to serve as a Jr. Superintendent, regardless of what LISD High School they attend.
- Late applications <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted. Applications MUST be turned in by the deadline and <u>signed by your Ag Teacher</u>.
- Each candidate <u>must</u> attend the interview on the interview date listed below. Selected interviewees will be notified by email.

Applications must be turned into your ag teacher by Monday, October 7th, 2019.

Ag Teachers: Please send all <u>signed applications</u> to Allison Hodde via District Mail by October 8th, 2019. Interview date will be October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 with a start time of 5 pm.

## Interviews:

Interview times will be scheduled 8-minute intervals.

Once Ms. Hodde has all applications from the Ag Teachers, she will send an email with more information on selecting an interview time.

**AWARDS:** Two Top Hand Jr. Superintendents will receive a Belt Buckle at Auction after voting has concluded.
